Hello Busy Bear's

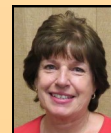

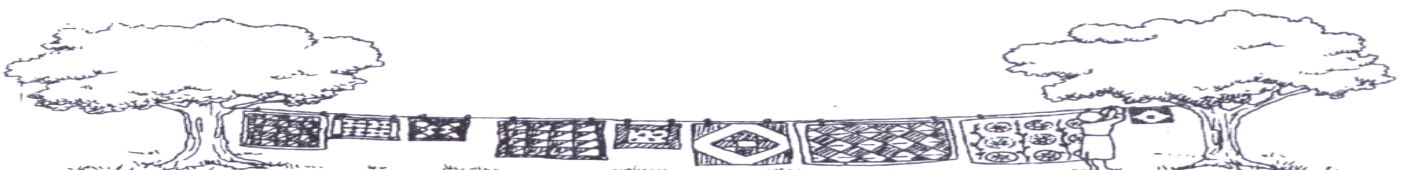
Mary Price has volunteered to replace Susie Meyers as the Raffle Baskets Chairperson next year.

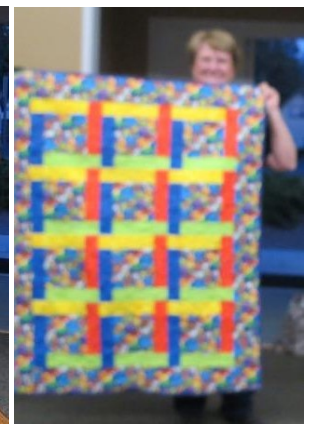

AUGUST PROGRAM: Challenge Quilts—see article for details.

AUGUST WORKSHOP: This will be a Boutique Workshop—time to finish all those projects.
