#### **Apple Bread**

(Kay) Higdon House B&B specialty

Adjusted for High Altitude

1. c sugar

3 T water or apple juice

3 c + 9 T flour (for lighter bread sift)

1/2 tsp baking soda

2 tsp vanilla

1 c pecans

1 c salad oil

4 eggs

1 tsp salt


1 tsp cinnamon

2 c chopped baking apples (I like to shred the apples still 2 c., about 3 apples)

325° oven. Bake 1 hour or until tooth pick comes out clean.

Spray 3 (5" x 9") loaf pans with Pam cooking spray.

Beat together sugar, oil, water or juice, and eggs. In a separate bowl, stir together dry ingredients. Add dry ingredients to batter and mix until blended. Stir in vanilla, apples and pecans. Pour evenly into prepared loaf pans. Enjoy!
