

"FINALLY FINISHED" 2016 UFO CHALLENGE

This year we are having a UFO challenge again. This is to give you a little motivation to get some of those UFO's FINALLY FINISHED!

There is a \$10 entry fee to play the game. All the entry fees will go into a jackpot and at the end, August of 2016, one lucky quilter will win the jackpot!

The game is a bit different this year. You need to do a little homework before you enter the challenge. You need to look through your UFO's and make a list of the UFO's you hope to complete, up to ten projects can be listed. I will have forms if you would like or a list from you will suffice. You need to list a basic description of each UFO project, basic size and color/pattern. Then when you complete a quilt and bring it to show, I will check it off of your list and give you an entry ticket.

They do not need to be done in any specific order and you do not need to complete them all. The minimum size to qualify is a crib/wall hanging size of 42" X 42".

Mom and Dad quilts do not qualify.

Doves quilts do not qualify.

Table runners do not qualify.

Each completed quilt earns an entry ticket and you can earn up to five entries. In August 2016 one ticket will be drawn and that quilter will win the jackpot. SO the more quilts you finish the more chances you'll have in the pot!

So look through your UFO's, make a list and let's get some quilts FINALLY FINISHED this year!


Looking ahead:

NEEDLE TURN APPLIQUE

At our May workshop, Needle Turn Applique, eight members gathered to learn the intricacies of this traditional hand applique method. We enjoyed Wendy Green's detailed instructions, and each of us worked on a simple practice project. We were especially impressed with the ease of preparation required for needle turn applique, and with how much sooner we were able to start stitching, as compared to some other hand applique methods. We all also learned not to stitch our pieces to a stray fold of background fabric or to our shirttail or to our finger!

BUSY BEAR QUILT GUILD BOUTIQUE GUIDELINES

If you are entering crafts or hand-made items at the Busy Bear Quilt Show, there are a few guidelines to follow:

GENERAL

- 1. All items must be hand-crafted by guild members
- 2. If you are selling items in the boutique, it would be great if you would sign up to work a shift or two in the boutique area during the show
- 3. All items must be listed on the Busy Bears 2016 Boutique Form. It will be printed in the June, July and August newsletters. It
 - will also be available to download from the Busy Bears website: www.busybearsquiltguild.com. This completed form must be submitted with your boutique items.

PREPARING THE BOUTIQUE FORM

- 1. List the items by number. Enter description, quantity and price
- 2. Enter multiples of the same item and price using one item number. Example: 5 birdhouses at \$40.00 each would be listed as Item #1, description-birdhouses, quantity 5 and price \$40 each.
- 3. Keep a copy of your boutique form for your personal use, as the original form will not be returned.

SUBMITTING ITEMS

- 1. Attach a removable string tag to each item. Make sure the tags are securely attached to each item. If necessary use a safety pin, tape or a sticky dot. Make sure each tag has Item #, your initials and price on one side.
- 2. Tags will be available at the July and August BBQG meetings.

Bring all items to the show site on the Friday before the show between 4:30 pm-6:00 pm. Please make sure your BBQG Boutique Form is complete. Please ensure all items are tagged properly, as it will make the check-in process go much faster. After all items have been checked in, the display process will take place.

PICKING UP ITEMS

Unsold items may be picked up Sunday after 4:30 pm. This process takes time as unsold items are inventoried and recorded on your boutique form, please be patient.

QUILT SHOW

It's summer, and that means Quilt Show activities are getting started!

Our 2016 quilt show, Mountain Treasures XXVIII, will be held on Saturday Sept. 3 from 10am – 5pm, and on Sunday Sept. 4 from 10am – 4pm. The show takes place at Big Bear Middle School. Admission this year has been increased to \$8, and children under 12 are free.

This month we will take orders for your purple guild tee-shirts, to be worn while you work your shift at the show as well as at other guild events. As in past years, the price is \$10 for sizes S - XL, and \$12 for XXL. They are Hanes 50/50 heavyweight tees, and they don't shrink much at all. Please bring exact change or plan to write a check when you place your shirt order.

We will also begin to take sign-ups at the June meeting for your volunteer time slots for show preparation and
operation. As a gentle reminder, all members are expected to work at least one shift during show weekend. We will
need help Friday evening setting up, as well as Saturday and Sunday in various capacities of show operation, and last
but not least on Sunday afternoon as we take down the show and clean up. More detailed information about these
volunteer activities will be presented at the June guild meeting. Bring your calendar and come ready to sign up and
support our guild!

Elsewhere in this month's newsletter you will find the form for entering quilts in the show, and for putting items in the boutique. Please note that paperwork for showing your quilt must be received no later than August 1, even if your quilt isn't quite done. The actual quilts will be accepted until Sunday August 28, and more information about that will be shared next month – just wanted you to have the submission deadline dates in mind as you plan your summer.

Our next Quilt Show meeting will take place at the June SEWcial on Monday June 13. We'll get started at 9:30 a.m. and welcome everyone's participation and suggestions! We have lots to do in the next few months, and we look forward to your support!


