



Busy Bears Quilt Guild Program Update for March

Our thanks go to Bonnie Snell for her Scrappy Quilt Workshop held in February. The participants
 were all pleased with the process and results.

Quilt Artist, Bonnie Marshall-Creel will be our presenter for our March meeting. She will share her creative adventure in designing quilts, along with a trunk show of her artworks.

Please note that Bonnie's Multi-Media Workshop will be held on Saturday, instead of Tuesday. The workshop includes the use of Bonnie's art supplies: water soluble watercolor crayons, fabric paint and watercolor pencils. Attendees need to bring pieces of good quality white fabric (the size you want to work with), foam board to work on and protect the table surface, and foam brushes in which to apply paint. The fee for this workshop (as well as all our workshops this year) is \$20 for members and \$35 for non-members.







Bonnie will show us how to use various mediums and techniques create our own fabric backgrounds with sky and water, as well as how to incorporate mountains, trees and rocks. Are you interested in creating faces? Bonnie will show us how to do that as well.

This workshop will give you some skills that could be incorporated into our April workshop, Confetti Landscapes, presented by Belinda Evans.

During our meeting this month, Belinda will explain preparation details needed to be done prior to the workshop in April.

Looking ahead for May \sim Sue Bouchard will bring us up to date on Modern Quilts and her workshop will be "Moon Dance", a pattern she designed for Quilt in a Day. You can make it lap quilt size (60" \times 84"), or a wallhanging (27" \times 38").
