

Busy Bears Program and Workshop Updates for March 2018

Our regular guild meeting was cancelled last month, but we still wanted to have our workshop, and so, Wendy Green graciously hosted the Needle Keep workshop at her home. We were all able to sit at her large dining room table, sip our coffee and sew together. We had a good time. Thank You Wendy!

This month we will have a double program; Lys Axleson will give us a Trunk Show of her creative quilts and introduce you to how embellishments can make a difference, and our past presidents will share stories and show the quilts that were gifted to them in appreciation for their service to the guild.

Lys is known for her embellishment skills, and on the following day, she will present a workshop, with a focus on beading. You will find the Supply List adjacent to this article. Here's hoping that you will take advantage of this opportunity to learn a new way in which you can add interest and color to your quilts.

Cost for the workshop is \$20 for members and \$35 for guests. Most members bring a sack lunch, coffee and snacks will be provided.

Looking ahead to April, Heidi Stagno, of Calimesa, will present, "How do I Quilt That Top". Her workshop the next day will be "Free Motion Quilting on Your Domestic Sewing Machine". I will have a sample of her work and the supply list for the class, at our March meeting.

Embellishment Workshop Supply List

Seed beads - Size 11, 8 or 6 - I use Size 11 for most projects and add the other sizes or unusual shapes to my designs.

Unusual size and shaped beads or other items you would like to use like buttons or charms etc.

Needles for beading - sometimes I use Size 9- 12 hand sewing needles if they go through the beads, and/or Size 12 beading needles.

Thread - you can use any type of sewing thread. Size 40wt or 50wt if you use regular cotton, cotton/poly or poly thread. I use Nymo-D or Silamide beading thread.

Beeswax or Thread Heaven/Thread Magic thread conditioner if you are going to use thread other than beading thread.

Thimble, scissors, eyeglasses. Any other sewing supplies you may want to bring.

Fabric with a printed design like flowers, birds or animals or graphic print that you would like to add beads to. A piece about 8" square or larger would be fine.

If you want to draw your own design, bring your drawing supplies or your completed drawing with you as well as a light colored piece of fabric like muslin to transfer the drawing to.

Flat tray or small plate with a small washcloth or small towel to pour the beads on to (so they don't roll away).

I will bring backing felt for your fabric.

Sometimes you can buy beads at the dollar store. They are Size 11. Get a couple packages of different colors.

You can also get a nice variety at Bear Country Quilts as well as Walmart and Joann's. It just depends on what you want to do and how much variety you want to have.


