General Meeting Minutes

May 18, 2026

I. Call to order

Lindy Edmond called to order the regular meeting of the Busy Bears Quilt Guild at 10:58 a.m. on May 18, 2026 at the Sugarloaf Park, 44828 Baldwin Ln, Sugarloaf, Ca. Pledge of Allegiance led by Michele Parris.

II. Approval of Minutes from last meeting

The minutes of the April 20, 2026 General Meeting as published in the May 2026 newsletter and available on our membership sign-in table were approved on a motion by Fran Martin, second by Teresa Georgi. The motion was carried and approved.

III. Open Issues

- a) **Treasurer Report** – Tammy Laubach reported the April 2026 treasurer's report. At the end of April, the checking account balance was \$12,148.17. The savings account balance for March was \$25,762.76. Tammy announced the Guild moved \$8,000 from the checking to savings. Nancy Gaylord motioned to approve the April treasurer's reports and Kelley Smythe seconded. All were in favor. Motion carried.
- b) **Membership** – Heidi Llanes reported the guild has 46 members and no guests today. There was nothing to report in the Idea Box. Lindy Edmond announced new membership cards were passed out at the last meeting. Sign-up sheet at the membership table if members didn't receive theirs. Members can present their cards to quilt shops for discounts. Cotton Gin is among the stores honoring the discount and currently 25% off fabric. Lindy will have Conversations with New Members in lieu of Coffee Chats. The new members can ask questions in person or over the phone.
- c) **Sunshine and Shadows** - Theresa Georgi announced the one birthday for May and the member declined members singing "Happy Birthday" to her.
- d) **Philanthropy** – Cathy Fraiser announced there are packets available.
- e) **Publicity and Marketing** - Open position.
- f) **2026 Opportunity Quilt** – Lorraine Taylor requested members to show the quilt. Lorraine suggested the Visitors Center to show the quilt over the Memorial Day weekend. A date is needed to draw the winner possibly near Labor Day. The Quilt Show Committee will discuss a date at their meeting.
- g) **2027 Opportunity Quilt** – Bonnie Snell sent out an email thanking all the members who helped picking out fabric, making blocks, etc. A flyer is needed to show the new quilt.
- h) **Programs** – Lindy Edmond discussed the upcoming programs, workshops, and adventures. Cathy said members want to have a Quilt Show but no one will volunteer to chair it. Lorraine Taylor said we can partner with other organizations such as the Art

Council. Arts Council is just getting started but looking at April 2027 and Christmas in the Moonridge Corridor. Today, Bonnie Snell spoke about the Scrappy Quilt, \$10, and she will give suggestions for pre-workshop prep. Lindy Edmond briefly explained August and September workshops. Debbie Pence spoke on the June Picnic, Tuesday, June 16th, 11 a.m., Sugarloaf Park. Games, potluck, cupcakes provided. Debbie needs help setting up around 10:30 a.m. Swap mug rug, pot holder, or a small wall hang.

JULY PROGRAM

Hello Quilters. I'm sorry I am not able to attend this month's Guild meeting, but I want to give you a little more information about the workshop that we are having in July.

This will be a very basic Scrap Quilt. It will go together easily, but there is some prep work needed.

- 1: first choose a FOCUS fabric. Choose a fabric that has many different colors in it.
- 2: then collect a variety of fabrics that have any shade of any color that is in your FOCUS fabric. 12 or more fabrics make the quilt interesting.

The **Bargain Table** has some great choices at great prices.

- 3: From your fabrics, cut 5 1/2 inch squares. You will need at least 120 squares. But you should cut an additional 25 or so. I know . . . that's a lot of squares.

DON'T STRESS - you have a month - cut a few at a time

This Quilt will be 50" x 60". Borders can be added if you want to make it larger.

TIME: 9:30 am - 12:30 pm

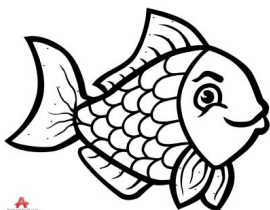
LOCATION: Cotton Gin Fabric, 700 E. Redlands Blvd., Suite I, Redlands

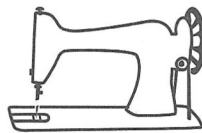
